

LYING WOMAN OF THE MONTH

Justice for men & boys (and the women who love them) presents the April 2014 **Lying Woman of the Month** award to Teresa Hughes, 39, who falsely alleged that the headmaster of the primary school where her daughter was a pupil had sexually assaulted her daughter.¹ The latest in a long line of cases where the justice system displays mind-boggling leniency towards women, regardless of the damage they've tried to wreak on men's lives and careers. It's little wonder that men have become disinclined to work as teachers, and that most teachers in the state education system are women. The headmaster likened the experience to having been diagnosed with cancer. The woman in this case, as in countless others, didn't even receive a suspended sentence. She received a short community order and a small fine, which wouldn't have come close to paying the costs to the taxpayer of taking the matter to court. She tried to ruin a fine man's career, and men have committed suicide after being the subject of false sexual assault allegations. We shouldn't be surprised that so many vile British women make false sexual assault allegations against men. The justice system encourages them to do so.
