

Content of two emails sent to the Cabinet Office concerning honours bestowed upon Laura Bates and Caroline Criado-Perez

Queen's birthday honours list - Fol request

Good morning.

I was shocked and appalled at the decision to present awards to two hate-driven lying feminists in the Queen's birthday honours list.

Caroline Criado-Perez is being given an OBE. She has won three of my party's 'Lying Feminist of the Month' awards. I was being interviewed with her on the ITV programme *This Morning*, and Philip Schofield asked her what she'd done to deserve the award. She said she'd lied, then laughed (video available if you want it). In the course of the discussion she lied again, leading to her third award.

Laura Bates is being given a BEM. She has won two of our 'Lying Feminist of the Month' awards, for lying publicly and repeatedly about the incidence of rape in the UK, and about the number of women being killed by partners and ex-partners every year in the UK.

Neither woman has been willing to retract her lies, let alone apologize for them. These feminists are relentlessly stoking up hatred among women towards men, and it beggars belief that they would be given an OBE and a BEM respectively.

My Fol request:

Please disclose whether any correspondence exists between either civil servants or ministers discussing the award of an OBE to Caroline Criado-Perez, or a BEM to Laura Bates, prior to the awards being made. If it exists please provide copies of any and all correspondence, both ministerial and civil service, in relation to this. Separately, please disclose whether any correspondence exists between either civil servants or ministers discussing these awards. In addition, I would ask for full copies of the relevant nomination forms, without redactions - including the names of the person(s) making the nominations - in line with a Decision Notice from the Information Commissioner's Office:
