We will be gathering to oppose the extreme abortion amendment to the Criminal Justice Bill put forward by pro-abortion MP Dame Diana Johnson. This amendment would mean that a woman could abort her baby up to birth without any criminal sanctions.

Abortion must stay within the criminal law to protect mothers and their unborn babies.
