



A call to women

‘Women’s liberation, if it abolishes the patriarchal family, will abolish a necessary substructure of the authoritarian state, and once that withers away Marx will have come true, willy nilly, so let’s get on with it.’

Germaine Greer, *The Female Eunuch* (1970)

Many women continue to identify as feminists although feminism is an offshoot of Marxism, it’s viscerally anti-marriage, anti-family, and deeply anti-meritocratic. It has long impacted adversely on the lives of women (and girls), as well as the lives of men (and boys). Feminism is a female supremacy movement driven by misandry – the hatred of men.¹ Over the past 30+ years in the UK, as in the majority of developed countries, feminists have progressively attacked the pillars of civilized society – including marriage, the family, government, public bodies, the media, the criminal justice system, education, and more. It continues to do so, ever more ruthlessly.

Harriet Harman MP is an obvious example of the feminists who have led the state’s assaults on marriage and the nuclear family. Her Marxist agenda was clear in 1990 in the IPPR report *The Family Way*, which she co-authored. She stated:

‘It cannot be assumed that men are bound to be an asset to family life, or that the presence of fathers in families is necessarily a means to social cohesion’.

Under David Cameron’s leadership the Conservative party has been strongly influenced by feminist thinking, pursuing all the feminist policy directions of the preceding Labour administrations (1997-2010). Herbert Purdy, a leading British anti-feminist blogger, wrote a powerful article on the matter.²

Women who say they’re feminists often say they believe in ‘gender equality’. J4MB regularly challenges feminists to outline the rights enjoyed by British men today, which are denied to women – what is the ‘gender equality’ they’re fighting for today? They’re invariably stumped, because there are none. By

contrast, in our 2015 general election manifesto, we'll be addressing 20 areas in which the human rights of British men (or boys) are assaulted by the state's actions or inactions, usually to advantage women (or girls). Many of our party's female supporters are appalled at their sons being educated in a state system designed to advantage girls over boys. Some of our female supporters are partners of men disadvantaged at work when less capable women are promoted above them. Some are grandmothers unable to see their grandchildren, because the family courts system fails to ensure parents (almost invariably fathers) and grandparents reasonable contact with their children.

We turn to the world of work. Dr Catherine Hakim, an eminent sociologist, published her 'Preference Theory' in 2000.³ Her research showed that while four in seven British men are 'work-centred' – with respect to paid employment – only one in seven British women is. The government drives women into work, although one consequence is to increase male unemployment, as Belinda Brown has reported.⁴ For many years, more men than women have been registered as unemployed and seeking work. The happiness of women and the wellbeing of children are of no interest to the people driving the government's policies with respect to employment, often through the tax system). Feminists – who are *hugely* over-represented among the one in seven British women who are work-centred – relish the idea of children being cared for by people other than their mothers.

Virtually all feminist claims and narratives are conspiracy theories, fantasies, lies, delusions or myths. This includes the claim that feminists were responsible for winning women the vote. The truth is that the Suffragettes were a *hindrance* to female emancipation.⁵

Feminists cynically lie to raise women's anxiety levels, to delude them into thinking that feminists – rather than men – are women's protectors. They routinely and *grossly* exaggerate the risk of women being sexually assaulted, women being subjected to domestic violence, and more. You've probably heard feminists claim, 'Over two women a week in the UK are being killed by partners or ex-partners'. It's a lie. In 2012/13, 76 women were killed by partners or ex-partners, and the figure had declined by around 25% over the preceding 10 years. Laura Bates was the founder of The Everyday Sexism Project⁶ and enjoys *astonishing* media exposure. She repeated the 'over two women a week...' mantra in a filmed presentation. Last month we publicly challenged her to retract the lie.⁷ She didn't respond, so we awarded her our 'Lying Feminist of the Month' award.⁸

The award has a link to an article by Herbert Purdy – 'Laura Bates, the child-woman, speaks again' – which outlines government statistics *proving* her claim to be a lie.⁹ We've published our own link to the evidence.¹⁰ Three days after Laura Bates was notified of the award, Owen Davies, a courageous young man, challenged her over her claim in the course of a televised BBC debate. Bates repeated her lie, brazenly ending with, 'That is *absolutely* the official figure'.¹¹

We've publicly challenged many feminists (and their male collaborators) to retract their lies, and not one has ever done so.¹² Caroline Criado-Perez has *twice* won our 'Lying Feminist of the Month' award.¹³ When women identify as feminists, they give cover to the ideologues who are destroying so much that women hold dear. As Herbert Purdy has pointed out, all women (and men) who identify as feminists are jointly responsible for the damage caused by feminists – the destruction of the nuclear family, in particular.¹⁴ In another article he pointed to a common factor in the sexual assaults of 1,400 children living in Rotherham, a factor all but unmentioned in the mainstream media – the absence in the children's lives of their natural protectors, their fathers.¹⁵

Enlightened women are rejecting feminism. The Women Against Feminism website¹⁶ continues to attract considerable attention, and we're seeing ever more 'Honey Badgers' – women who publicly identify as non-feminists, anti-feminists, or men's human rights advocates. Many contribute to A Voice for Men,¹⁷ the most-visited and most influential men's human rights advocacy website in the world. One is a Canadian, Karen Straughan – 'GirlWritesWhat'. Her videos are remarkable.¹⁸

It's time for women and men to join forces and publicly denounce feminism as the hate movement it undoubtedly is today. Feminists are deeply entrenched in state institutions including Parliament, so there will have to be a political battle. We owe it to the men, women, and children, who suffer at the hands of feminists, to drive these hate-driven women out of positions of influence, and to denounce the politicians – including David Cameron and Ed Miliband – who dance so enthusiastically to their tunes.
