

LYING FEMINIST OF THE MONTH

Caroline Criado-Perez



J4MB presents Caroline Criado-Perez with the January 2015 ‘Lying Feminist of the Month’ award, the third such award she’s won in the past eight months. In May 2014 she won the award for lying about the impact of female board directors on corporate financial performance.¹ In October 2014 she won the award for lying in a *New Statesman* piece, published online, ‘Domestic abuse is the largest cause of morbidity in women aged 19-44, more than war, cancer, or motor vehicle accidents’.² In the course of a televised discussion she cheerfully admitted she’d won a ‘Lying Feminist of the Month’ award *because she’d lied* – 3:21 on the edited video of the discussion.³ She wins her third award for lying in the course of the same discussion. At 1:21 on the edited video, she’d claimed:

A woman is killed every 2.38 days by a male partner in the UK.

This equates to 153 women p.a., while the latest official statistic (which includes killings by ex-partners) is 75.⁴ In response to Mike Buchanan’s challenge of her claim, later in the discussion, she stated:

I didn’t say (the women were killed) by male partners or ex-partners, I said by men.
